RULES & REGULATIONS OF THE SOCIETY

THE SOCIETY	Shall be called EXETER AMATEUR RADIO SOCIETY
OBJECTS	To encourage Amateur Radio in all its aspects
OFFICERS	Shall consist of Chairman, Hon. Secretary, Hon. Treasurer and Public Relations Officer
THE COMMITTEE	Shall consist of the four officers and two other elected members. The committee shall have the power to co-opt other members to the committee as and when it thinks fit. The Committee shall arrange the business of the society.
ELECTIONS	Shall take place at the Annual general Meeting or Extraordinary Meeting which may be called for that purpose. The Committee shall be elected by a majority vote of members present at either of these meetings and shall serve until the next AGM
MEMBERSHIP	<p>Membership shall be open, subject to the discretion of the Committee, to all persons interested in the aims of the Society.</p> <p>All members shall abide by the constitution of the Society. The Committee shall have power to expel any member whose conduct, in the opinion of the majority of the full committee, renders that person unfit to be a member of the Society.</p> <p>No Member shall be expelled without first having been given the opportunity to appear before the Committee</p>
ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING	Shall be held during the month of March each year. At the AGM reports from the Hon. Secretary and Hon. Treasurer shall be presented for approval by the members. Any items for inclusion in the Agenda must be submitted to the Hon. Secretary in writing twenty one clear days before the AGM.

EXTRAORDINARY
GENERAL MEETING

Shall be called by the Committee or by any six members of the Society, by application in writing, stating purpose, to the Hon. Secretary. The Hon Secretary shall convene such a meeting within 42 days of being so required.

QUORUM

A quorum at an AGM or Extraordinary Meeting shall consist of 20% of the current membership. A quorum at Committee meetings shall consist of three elected members.

AMENDMENTS

To the Society rules shall only be made at AGM or an Extraordinary Meeting called for that purpose.

PRESIDENT,
VICE PRESIDENTS

May be proposed at the AGM to serve until the following AGM

LIFE MEMBERS

Honorary Life members may be elected at the AGM

NOTICE OF MEETING

In the case of AGM the Hon. Secretary shall give 28 clear days notice of the meeting. In all other cases not less than 14 clear days notice shall be given. Failure to serve notice on any individual member shall not invalidate the proceedings.

SUBSCRIPTIONS

Shall be agreed by the members present at the AGM or Extraordinary Meeting called for that purpose. Subscriptions become due at the AGM. Any member failing to renew the subscription by 31 May shall cease to be a member of the Society. New members joining the Society after 30th September shall pay one half of the subscription fee for that year.

MONIES

Of the Society shall be kept in account with the Halifax Building Society or such other building society or bank. as general meeting of the Society shall determine from time to time. Withdrawals from the Society's account must bear the signatures of two committee members.
